Regular courses such as mandatory training and public policy courses

Policy agendas; policy priority	Understanding and sharing the policy goals & tasks of the government
Public sector ethics	Establishing the work ethics required of public officials
Leadership; self-improvement	Developing public leadership to successfully manage an organization
ICT; informatization	Learning the latest trends in ICT and office automation tools
General job skills	Enhancing necessary general workplace skills, such as payment systems, personnel transfer and service requirements
Specific job skills	Enhancing areas of expertise such as accounting, tax and procurement
Global affairs	Improving officials' ability to respond to the rapidly-changing global political landscape and policy environment
Humanities	Offering opportunities for self-reflection through humanities subjects including culture, history and philosophy
Life and health	Laying a foundation for happy life through programs like parent training and healthcare
Language skills	Providing language content including English and Chinese, Japanese, Spanish courses

Government e-Learning platform operating process

General courses

Government content	Course content related to public service values, leadership, and job skills that government employees need
Knowledge content	Excellent private sector content on topics such as tech trends, the economy, management and the humanities
Language content	Linguistic content for English, Japanese etc
Gov-Mooc	Excellent in-class lectures and single course content

Other courses

Micro learning courses	User Select which course content to learn
Community Group-linked courses	e-Learning courses linked with a community group courses
Customized courses for agencies	Courses are customized for government and public agencies that have difficulties in running their own e-Learning courses
Open courses	Courses can be taken without an application process

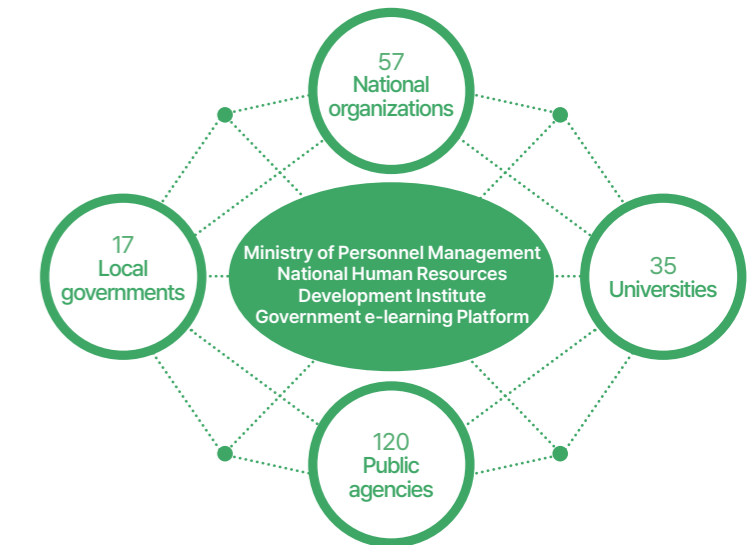


The Government e-learning Platform is a collaborative system.

The Government e-learning Platform shares and jointly uses its training system and content with public agencies as well as central and local training organizations, thereby creating cost-effective management and an extensive learning experience.

*Participating agencies: National Human Resources Development Institute, central administrative organizations, municipal or provincial partner training organizations, national universities, etc.

Benefits for Shared-service

- Sharing the training system and content increases the content usage by various sectors and lowers government spending.
- The system can train personnel in charge of systems and e-learning operations, collect opinions via e-learning conferences, and offer customized e-learning consultation for each organization.
